

Gustavo Petro insists on being targeted

During the opening of the Human Sciences building at UIS, the Colombian president expressed his discontent with justice, accusing them of persecuting his allies. The president openly criticized the judicial branch and control entities, such as the Attorney General's Office, during the inauguration of the new building of the Faculty of Human Sciences of the Industrial University of Santander (UIS) in Bucaramanga.

President Gustavo Petro addressed various topics, including the election of the attorney general, the decarbonization of the economy, and the democratization of [Ecopetrol](#), during his speech to the university students. He also expressed his concern about what he considers attacks against his administration by the Supreme Court of Justice, the Attorney General's Office, and the Prosecutor's Office.
