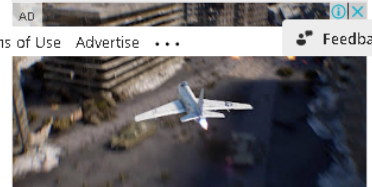



Titan sub disaster victim Shahzada Dawood died without a valid UK will so left less than £100,000 to his wife in Britain - despite being the heir to a £1.3billion-a-year business empire in Pakistan, MailOnline can reveal today. Mr Dawood, (Pictured right) 48, and his 19-year-old son Suleman (pictured left) were two of the five victims killed instantly when the OceanGate submersible suffered a 'catastrophic implosion' just 1,600ft from the bow of the Titanic.
