BOGOTA, July 7 (Reuters) - Colombian state oil firm **Ecopetrol** ([ECO.CN](#)) said on Monday it has purchased a wind power project in the northern province of La Guajira from Enel ([ENEI.MI](#)).

The Windpeshi project will have capacity to produce 205 megawatts, "which will be immediately incorporated into the **Ecopetrol** Group's self-consumption portfolio," the company said in a statement.
