

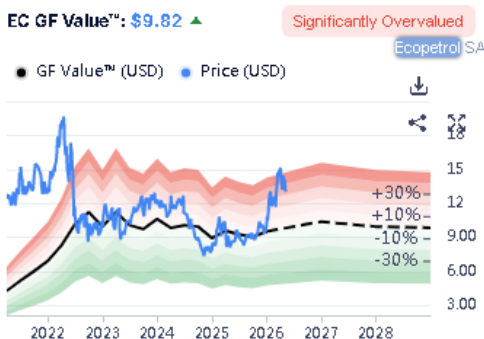
Ecopetrol (EC) Faces Credit Rating Downgrade by Moody's

On May 07, 2026, **Ecopetrol** **EC** **-2.69%** **72** experienced a downgrade in its global credit rating by Moody's Ratings, falling from Ba1 to Ba2. The outlook has shifted from stable to negative. Moody's has maintained **Ecopetrol's** Baseline Credit Assessment, indicating a stand-alone credit profile of b1.

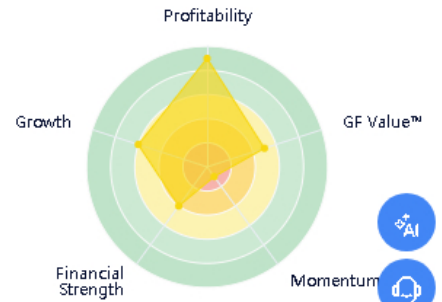

The downgrade by Moody's reflects a diminished outlook on the support from the Colombian government, which is a crucial factor for **Ecopetrol's** operations. This change is attributed to increasing concerns about potential government interference and a lack of clarity regarding the reliability and timing of support measures, especially those involving the Fuel Price Stabilization Fund. The negative outlook raises questions about the company's future financial stability and its ability to navigate potential challenges in the energy sector.

Ecopetrol SA is a leading oil and gas company engaged in various activities, including exploration, exploitation, refining, and distribution of hydrocarbons. It operates through four business segments: Exploration and Production, Transport and Logistics, Refining and Petrochemical, and Electric Power Transmission and Toll Roads Concessions. 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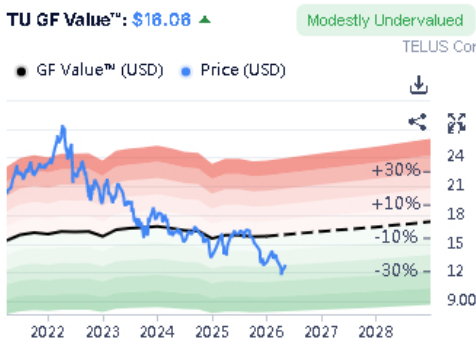
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TELUS (TU) Reports Q1 Revenue Dip with Strong Customer Growth
